Mandatory Information meeting and final

registrations: Saturday, March 28 at 10:30am at St.

James Church.

Mandatory Documents: 1- Registration Form (through a QR code) & 2- Baptism Certificate.

Catechesis (classes) Schedule: will begin after Holy Week, on Saturday, April 11 at 10:30am and will be held every Saturday (except Saturday, May 16) until Saturday, May 30. The celebration of First Communion will be on June 6, Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi) at St. James Church.

First Reconciliation: Wednesday, June 3 at 7:00pm

Attendance: required for both parents and children for the in-class sessions. Attendance at Mass on Sundays is obviously obligatory for every practicing Catholic. Parents are obliged to transmit faith to their children, and the bare minimum is Sunday Mass attendance. In this context, school mass does not count as fulfilling the precept required by the Church.
