THE BOOK OF LIFE

We will have the book of life available during the month of November at the church. Special envelopes will be available for donations.

THE ADORATION CHAPEL

An Adoration Chapel is a sacred space dedicated to the worship and adoration of the Holy Eucharist, where individuals can come before the Real Presence of Jesus Christ to pray, reflect, and deepen their faith. It is open 7 days a week, offering continuous opportunities for prayer. The Eucharist, reserved in a monstrance, is available for public adoration. All who wish to spend time with Our Lord in the Blessed Sacrament are asked to see the following guidelines.

UPDATED GUIDELINES TO HAVE ACCESS TO THE ADORATION CHAPEL AT ST. JAMES (STARTING DECEMBER 2025)

1.- Call the office for registration (see bulletin for office hours). You might be asked to fill a background or police check form to receive the codes of the doors.

2.- Only once you are approved, you will be called and asked to come to the office for a brief explanation on how to access the chapel and other important actions to follow inside it.

3.- For your safety, it is strictly forbidden to share the code with someone else without the proper procedure and permission from the pastor. Failing to comply to this may take away the privilege to visit the chapel.

4.- You need to check in by writing your name and time; and check out when you leave

5.- The chapel will no longer be a private visit. Someone else may have access at the same time.

6.- For your safety a 24-hour camera is active at the entrance of the chapel.

7.- Other changes (clear door, inside camera, different sitting and kneeling arrangement) will be made to assure a greater security and comfort for those who visit the chapel.

8.- Moments not-available for adoration:

- When the Blessed Sacrament is exposed in the Church
- When Good Friday is being celebrated

9.- Hours of Adoration:

- Tuesday: 3pm to 12 midnight
- Wednesday, Thursday, Saturday: 6am to 12 midnight (except 8am to 9am, the Blessed Sacrament is exposed in the Church.)
- Friday: 6am to 12 midnight (except 8am to 9am & 5pm to 6:30pm, the Blessed Sacrament is exposed in the Church.)
- Sunday: 6am to 12 midnight
